DAY ONE

Alberta Premier Ed Stelmach will deliver the Luncheon Keynote Address with an update on Canada's more prosperous province and their use of PPP. **Canada's Minister of Finance, Hon. James Flaherty**, will give an overview of PPP Canada Inc. **Livingston, Wevers, Blain, Lefebvre** and **Lusk** will review the highlights in AFP and PPP and look to the activity we can expect in 2009. **Paul Tellier** will explore with **Lazio, Laramée, Munsuri, Hann** and **Maloney** the characteristics of the 3 markets – Canada, USA and Mexico. **Brown, Charette, Park, Gash, Pomerleau** and **Fisher**, will consider PPP and the impact on construction companies.
