DAY ONE

Keynote Speeches by **BC Premier Gordon Campbell** and **Canada's Minister of Finance, Hon. James Flaherty**. A political session moderated by **CBC's Ian Hanomansing** with distinguished **political thinkers (Hon. Lloyd Snelgrove, Bob Chiarelli, Martha Hall Findlay, Rob Sampson, Bernard Lord)** on the Politics of PPP. A Great Debate session moderated by **Frank McKenna** on Constructor Led vs. Investor Led solutions with **McArthur, Brown, de Medici and Hann**. A **virtual hard-hat tour** of progress on Canada's Leading PPP's under construction (Canada Line, Sea-to-Sky, New Brunswick's new Highway and the Golden Ears Bridge). **Duncan McCallum** will be joined by **E.R. Yescombe**, author of the recently released "Public-Private Partnerships: Principles of Policy and Finance", **Tim Philpotts and Larry Blain** as they address managing **changes in control** and **refinancings**. And the heads of Canada's PPP agencies - **Larry Blain, Pierre Lefebvre, David Livingston and Alberta's Jay Ramotar** - give us a glimpse into how PPP is performing and what is coming in 2008!

DAY TWO

Canada's Minister of Transportation, Infrastructure and Communities, **Hon. Lawrence Cannon**, starts the day off discussing the critical requirement of infrastructure to facilitate cross-border movements. Two sessions will look at the Windsor-Detroit project and **financing** big North American **infrastructure** projects chaired by **Louis Ranger** and **ROB's John Stackhouse**. **US Assistant Secretary for Transportation Policy, DOT, Tyler Duvall**, will get us up-to-date on US Policy concerning PPP at lunch. Innovation to meet a green agenda, risk identification in operations, and **transportation payment mechanisms** will be addressed. **Pierre Lortie** will lead a panel examining the competition for attracting **Hospital** bidders in a heated market. As Alberta brings on 18 PPP **schools**, international guests assist us in building a best practice for Canada. Top experts in **recreation** PPP's (**Bidulka, Frittenburg, Sproule and Mackay**) will establish the rules for PPP Recreation projects so we can keep this sector performing into the future... and much, much more.
